Air-Acetylene Equipment

Follow these safety precaution when working with air-acetylene equipment; keep a fire extinguisher handy. Always wear safety glasses and goggles. Keep cylinders away from heat, sparks or open flames. Always stand to one side when adjusting its regulator, a defective regulator can blow out and cause injury, and never adjust the regulator above 15 psig. Acetylene becomes unstable at excessive pressures. Always store and transport cylinders in a cart or in a secured upright position. Finally, do not open the valve on an acetylene tank more than 1-1/2 turns.

Brazing and Soldering Fumes

Brazing and soldering alloys and fluxes may produce fumes which are hazardous to your health. Keep these safety tips in mind; keep your head out of the fumes, provide adequate ventilation to keep fumes and gases from your breathing zone and the general area, and always wear correct eye, ear and body protection.

SAFETY TIP

Ventilation

Heating, air conditioning and refrigeration equipment is occasionally installed in areas with little or no ventilation. These areas may pose some hazards for a technician while servicing and maintaining these systems.

While working in these poorly ventilated areas, a technician may need to provide his own means of ventilation. This is especially true when working with hazardous chemicals or while working with a torch. Always make sure a work area is well-ventilated when working under these conditions.



Providing adequate ventilation may be as simple as opening a door or window, or it may require the use of some type of exhaust fan.
